

Did you know that the USGS store allows you to download FREE topographical maps. If not try this:

1) Download and install the latest Adobe Reader. You can find this at: <http://www.adobe.com/downloads/>

2) Download the MAP 2 (to) PDF file from <http://www.terragotech.com/solutions/acrobat.php> and install this.

3) Now install the file you downloaded which is probably called GeoPDFToolbar.exe

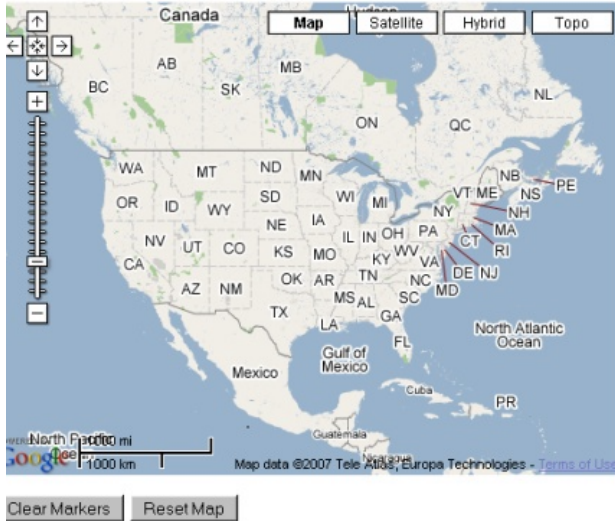
4) Go to <http://store.usgs.gov/> and CLICK ON the new link Map Locator and Downloader, where GeoPDF map files are now available.



5) Then click on the NEW Map Locator and Downloader



6) And follow the directions...



STEP 1.

SEARCH:

OR
FIND A PLACE ON THE MAP [\[Navigation Tips\]](#)

FIRST, NAVIGATE around the map: double click to re-center, click and drag to pull the map around, zoom in and out.

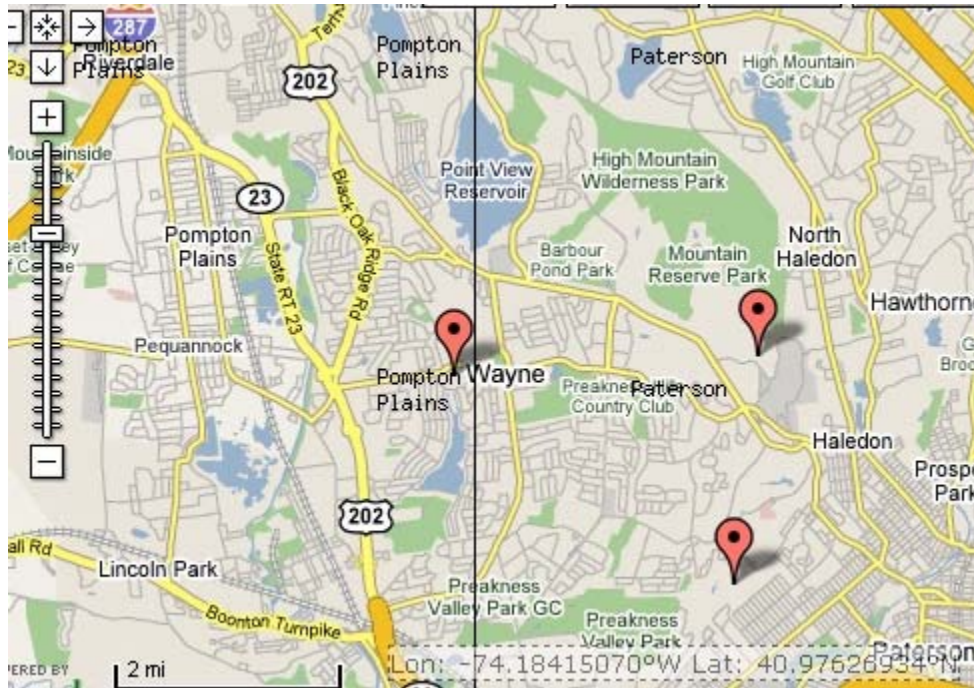
THEN, MARK POINTS on the map: click on a place to add a marker .
