## The Best Way to Load Geocaches on Tritons

The best way to load geocaches on the Triton is to clear the memory and place the gpx file in the VP library and then using the menu in the VP circle (upper left) loading the gpx file.

Then you have to go back in and reconfigure the memory on the Triton.

The other option would be to delete all geocaches in VP, synch, then add your GPX file. Sync again.

Clear the entire memory and reload and avoid the UDS manager issue, and you won't get the an outdoornav.exe error.

Another way is to use Vantage Point and the Sync/Transfer option all the time. The trick I have found is to NOT delete all caches and add them back in again but to just up date the caches in Vantage Point and let the Sync do the rest.

However, the Sync/Transfer takes a long time to complete. Typically load around 200 caches at a time.
